Dear Camper, Coach or Parents,

We received your 2009 ***on line camp application*** for your session choice. We look forward to having you with us. Thanks for choosing CCSC for your soccer development. ### REGISTRATION DAY

You have registered for your camp session of your choice paid your camp fees by credit card in full. If you do not hear from us in 48 hours please consider your registration permanent for the session you selected because it's not yet sold out.

At registration (first day) campers and visiting team coaches are required to turn in a separate check of \$50.00 made out to CCSC for your **Key and Room Deposit** (no cash). **No room key will be issued with out paying this fee.** This deposit check is to be returned to each camper and coach at check-out on the last day of camp providing you've not lost your key and no room damage has occurred. Registration and check-ins to camp and room assignments are between 10:30 AM – 12:30 PM (ends) your first day of camp. Please follow camp registration signs when you arrive on campus. If you need directions go to our website at **Camp Directions and Camp Location.**

**A room will be assigned to you and your room mates at checking-in.** Two players per room and rooms are air-conditioned. If you need a room mate we'll assign you one. Female and Male campers live in different dorms. If you're coming with a team your coach will make this arrangement prior to registration day with us or at registration day. It's best at registration that you are in line with your roommate to make this happen.

### PURCHASING A CAMP SOCCER BALL

If you want to purchase a logo camp soccer ball this can be done at registration for \$25.00. We will have a limited supply. All players are **required** to have a soccer ball in their possession while at camp. By purchasing a soccer ball all profits go to support at risk kids play the game through GSM International.

## **CAMP ACTIVITIES START**

At 1:15 PM you will attend a general camp meeting to meet staff, your coach and learn about your week of camp, after which training will start, all you can eat suppers is next (your first on campus meal), your evening evaluation match and then evening non-soccer recreational activities.

Your **Daily Camp Schedule** can be found on our website home page. Parents are welcome to watch training sessions and matches. The last camp match starts at 2:30 PM last day of camp, so please join us.

Dorm rooms have no refrigerators. **Washing Clothing** is available in your dorm. Bring your own **detergent** and camper/coaches will be able to **purchase washing tokens** from the campus business office for a moderate cost.

The camp will host a **Camp Store** which will take pizza orders, sell drinks, snacks and some soccer gear, t-shirts, balls, etc. We are often asked how much money a camper should bring for shop purchases. We suggest no more than \$100. There is **no Camp Bank** and Campers will be responsible for the keeping of their own money. All dorm rooms doors should remained locked and camper will be reminded of this daily. All store profits go to GSM International and help at risk kids play soccer in Guatemala, Haiti and Jamaica.

## **2010 CCSC/GSM INTERNATONAL SOCCER TOURS**

This summer, our Camp Soccer Tour Director will be setting up several tour teams for female and male players for our 2010 summer trips to Guatemala, Jamaica (late June) or Scotland (late July). We're just letting you know ahead of time. These will be for teams that are U-18 and U-16 age groups and the trip will be 9 day tours.

You may also email at **pbanta@sc.rr.com**. Emails are checked after the day of soccer and before breakfast.

We strongly recommend campers bring a cell phone and phone cards to communicate with home. **Cell phones** are not used during training sessions, matches and camp meeting. No office phones will be available for campers to call home unless there is an emergency and this would be done only through our camp directors.

## **WHAT TO BRING, REFUND POLICY, MEDICAL ASSISTANCE and CAMPER VEHICLES ARE LOCATED ON OUR WEBSITE**

Go to our camp website for all camp information. All Campers, Parents and Coaches need to review this information before coming to camp.

**What to Bring to Camp** is located on our website home page under Camp Site.

**Our Camp Refund** policy is located on our website at the bottom of the home page under Camp Policies.

**Camper Vehicles** are not to be used by your son or daughter while at camp. Please review our policy on **camper who brings their vehicle** to camp at Camp Policies on our websites. Campers will not be allowed to use their vehicles while at camp. Keys will be given to Joel Banta, Camp Assistant Director after the general camp meeting held the first day of camp and returned at checkout last day. Thank you for your understanding with this liability policy.

**Our Certified Athletics Training Staff** are on campus to serve each player needs as needed. Player coming to camp with a previous injury and yet clear by a physician to attend camp and participate fully in camp activities must on the first day share the injury or previous illness with the head trainer for insurance purposes.

## **CHECKING OUT OF CAMP**

Checking out of camp takes place only on the last day at 4:30 PM after final matches. A room inspection will take place during the match by the campus housing staff. All rooms are inspected before campers leave for damages. **No early check out will be allowed** without prior knowledge of the Camp Directors, Paul or Joel Banta. **No camper has permission to leave camp until parents have notified one of the camp directors.** No camper is to leave the campus other than for a soccer reason with their coaching staff. For Teams to go off campus with their own coach, away from regular camp activities, requires permission from one of the camp directors. Our insurance does not include non-supervised off campus activities. Emails are a good way to do this.
